Inspector's Comments

The facility is operated in a detailed manner. The facility physical structure and the staff members are flexible in the operations of the facility. The staff members travel with the youth through their day. The sanitation of the building is a high priority. The Facility Operations Administrator produced a comprehensive cleaning scheduled. The staff members in the different areas were well aware of the day's schedule and the operation of the facility as a whole. The disciplinary process in place shows attention to the need for redirection and possible sanction requirements for the choices of the youth. The grievance policy and procedure for the youth is in place. The school is administered by the Regional Office of Education System. Each youth is entered into the school system a day or two after arrival. All youth were in an education part of the daily schedule during the inspection. The recreational schedule is vigorous with multiple locations within the facility to recreate. The youth were busy during the inspection. The youth in this facility are greatly served by the staff members on duty, The youth are known by all staff which translates in to an environment that precludes the official discipline system to be employed. It was expressed by staff members and youth that there is usually verbal direction that is given and that the youth change their behavior. The facility was quiet during the inspection. The youth's rooms were clean and orderly. The facility is in the progress of receiving a new coat of paint. The county and facility have built a court room within the facility that aids the youth and their families in dealing with the county court system without having to travel across the city. This new court room offers the youth the ability to have their support network to meet in one place to concentrate on the case and how to build a fame work to keep the youth away from the issues that brought him/her to the JDC.
