#### **Inspector's Comments**

The facility is operated in a orderly and controlled manner. The sanitation of the building is a priority of the facility. The Facility Operations Administrator produced a very rigorous and detailed cleaning scheduled that was comprehensive and complete. The staff members in the different areas were well aware of the day's schedule and the operation of the facility as a whole. The facility was very quiet during the inspection. The disciplinary process in place shows attention to the need for redirection and possible sanction requirements for the choices of the youth. The grievance policy and procedure for the youth is in place. The school is administered by the Regional Office of Education System. Each youth is entered into the school system a day or two after arrival. All youth were in an education part of the daily schedule during the inspection. There are many programs in action at the school away from normal academics. The recreational schedule is active. There was very little down time observed by the inspector. The youth were busy during the inspection. The facility was quiet during the inspection. The youth's rooms were clean.
